Initial premises

Operational guidelines. Please take the simple guidelines instructions below as a reference.

Note:

If you have registered your account and added your device previously, when you reinstall the app and log in, the previously added device will remain.



3. Location and appearance of the Wi-Fi module in the indoor unit

Open the front panel, the Wi-Fi module is near the electrical box cover or on the panel.

For iOS smartphones

Method 1: Scan the QR code and follow the prompts to access the "App Store", download and install the app. Method 2: Open the Apple "App Store" on your smartphone and search for "SmartLife-SmartHome", download and install the app.

The first time you use the app, you will need to activate it.1. Start


the "SmartLife-SmartHome" APP on your smartphone.

Method 2: Tap "or enter activation code" at the bottom of the screen, then enter the activation code and tap "CONFIRM".






Note Without the QR code or activation code, you can't activate the APP and use it, keep them safe.

The app can open the map on your phone and you can set your location.



- 4.Set your new password and tap the "Done" button.











There are 2 modes CF (Quick Connect) and AP (Access Point) for adding device.


CF Mode

- 1. Turn on the indoor unit, no need to start the air conditioner.
- 2.Click the "+" in the upper right corner of the Home screen or tap "Add Device" in the room that has no devices.
- 3. Tap the "Split Air Conditioner" logo.
- 4.Enter the Wi-Fi password that is the same as the one of your connected smartphone, then tap "Next".
- 5.Follow the prompts on the next screen to reset the Wi-Fi module, then select "Confirm device reset" and tap "Next."
- 6.You can see the percentage of the connection process, at the same time PP", "SA", "AP" shining in turn on the internal display.
 - "PP" means "Searching the router" "SA"
 - means "connected to the router" "AP"
 - means "connected to the server"














There are 2 methods to add the device.


Mode 2-AP

- 1. Turn on the indoor unit, no need to start the air conditioner.
- 2.Click the "+" in the upper right corner of the Home screen or tap "Add Device" in the room that has no devices.
- 3. Tap the "Split Air Conditioner" logo.
- 4.Enter the Wi-Fi password that is the same as the one of your connected smartphone, then tap "Next".
- 5.Tap on the top right corner and choose "AP Mode"

 Then follow the on-screen prompts to reset the Wi-Fi module, then select
 "Confirm device reset" and tap "Next".
- 6.Read the instructions carefully and tap "Connect Now".
- 7.On the network settings screen, select "SmartLife-****" and tap "<".
- 8.You can see the percentage of the connection process,at the same time "PP","SA","AP" lights up in turn on the internal display.
- "PP" means "Searching the router" "SA"
- means "connected to the router" "AP"
- means "connected to the server"








The device control screen will appear automatically after adding the device.

The device control screen will be displayed manually by tapping the device name on the home screen.





The main control interface



inpost mode

- 1.Tap Mode to bring up the Mode screen.
- 2.Select one of the Feel/Cool/Heat/Dry/Fan modes.
- 3. Touch anywhere around the set temperature to cancel the mode setting.



sselect the fan speed

- 1.Tap Fan to bring up the Fan screen.
- 2.Select one of the fan speeds High/Medium/Low/Auto.
- 3. Touch anywhere around the set temperature to cancel the selection.



Setting the function


- 1.Tap Function to bring up the Function screen.
- 2.Select one of the Sleep/Turbo/ECO functions.
- 3.Select SU-GIU/LEFT-RIGHT for automatic swing with UP-DOWN directionU/LEFT-RIGHT.
- 4. Touch anywhere around the set temperature to cancel the function setting.


- 1.Tap Timer to bring up the Add Timer screen.
- 2.Tap Add Timer.






Adding timer

- 3. Select time, select repeat days and Timer on/off.
- 4. Select Mode/Fan Speed/Function and select the setting temperature for Timer on.
- 5.Tap Save to add the timer.




- 1. Tap the timer bar to edit the timer as in the process of adding the timer.
- 2.Click the switch to enable or disable the timer.
- 3. Press and hold the timer bar for about 3 seconds and the Remove Timer screen will appear, tap CONFIRM and remove the timer.

Setting mode

- 1.Tap the Mode button.

- 4.The mode and wallpaper will change on the screen.

- 1.Tap the Fan Speed button.
- 2.Select the desired fan speed and tap it.
- 3.Tap the X button to return to the main control screen.
- 4.The selected fan speed indicator will appear on the screen.





Cairflow control

- 1.Tap the Precision Airflow button or the Oscillating Airflow button.
- 2.Select the airflow you want and tap it.
- 3.Tap the X button to return to the main control screen.
- 4.The selected airflow indicator will appear on the screen.

Note:For some models without automatic left-to-right wind, if you activate it, you will hear a beep, but no action.







Note:The main control screen and the airflow screen may appear slightly different, depending on of the air conditioner model. Example below:






FECO anointing

- 1.For Eco function, just touch the button to activate the function, the button will light up and the indicator will appear on the screen.
- 2.Tap again to disable the function.
- 3. Temperature controlled for some models of air conditioners: in cooling mode, the new set temperature will be

≥ 26 °C. ≤ 25 °C.

- 1.Tap the Sleep button.
- 2. Select the desired sleep mode and tap it.
- 3.Tap the X button to return to the main control screen.
- 4.The selected sleep mode indicator will appear on the screen.



- 4. The timer (off) will appear on the main Timer screen.





Timer Management

1.Change the timer setting:


Tap anywhere on the timer list bar except the switch bar to access the timer settings screen, change the setting, and then tap save.


2.Enable or disable the timer:


Tap the left side of the switch to disable the timer. Tap the right side of the switch to enable the timer.

3.Delete timer:

Swipe the Timer list bar from right to left until the Delete button appears, then tap Delete.







Other functions

1.Tap the More button to activate additional features if it appears on the screen.



Note: Some models of air conditioners do not't have the plus button.



Note: Appearance may vary, some icons will be hidden if your air conditioning does not have this function or is not enabled in the current mode.

2.Touch"

"to turn on/off the internal LED display.

3.Touch"



"to activate/deactivatethe sound alarmwhile operating via Wi-Fi APP.

4.Touch the "

" button to activate the Anti-Mold function, if available on the screen.

After the air conditioning is turned off, it will start to dry, reduce the residual humidity and prevent mold, when finished of the function, it will turn off automatically.

5.Touch the " Health




" button to enable/disable the healthy function, if available on the screen.

Activates the antibacterial ionizer function. This function is only available for models with an ionizer generator.

6.Tap the "GEN Mode" button, if available on the screen. In this mode, you can choose one of three power levels. The air conditioner will maintain the appropriate power to save energy.







Other functions

7. Tap the "Electricity Monitor" button if it is available on the screen.

In this function, you can monitor the electricity consumption of the air conditioner.





8.Touch the " Self-cleaning

Check the details of the self-cleaning function in the User Manual.

9.Touch the "8" button°CHeat", if available on the screen. This feature helps keep the room temperature above 8°C. Check the details of function 8°C Heat on the User Manual.



10. Tap the "Book" button, if available on the screen.

You can set the time, repeat the day, temperature, mode, fan speed, and airflow as desired, and then tap Save to activate the function. The air conditioner will automatically reach your settings at the scheduled time.







Other functions

11. Touch the "Self-diagnosis" button, if available on the screen. The air conditioner will automatically perform a diagnosis and display the error code and problem instructions, if possible.





12.Click the "



" if it is available on the screen.

This function allows the air conditioner to automatically turn the display on/off based on the light intensity.

13.Click the "



" if it is available on the screen.

In this function, the air conditioner will blow a soft stream of air through the micro holes on the deflector.






How to share devices with other accounts?

- 5.Received sharing members need to long press on the home screen and swipe down to refresh the device list, the device will appear in the device list.














StoYou will need to reconnect the air conditioner in CF mode. 2. In case of power failure, the mobile device will lose the air conditioner control permission. for 3 minutes after the power outage. (The notification will now appear on your mobile device.) If you cannot control the app (air conditioner) even after power is restored, you will need to Reconnect the air conditioner in CF mode. |
